RE: 2009 Annual Report

The following items were performed in 2009.

A. 2009 Street Repair Program

1. The 2009 Street Repair Program provided for the removal of the existing pavement and the installation of a new asphalt pavement with concrete combined curb and gutter for Dalton Road from Mackinaw Avenue to Revere Road which also included the installation of new storm sewers, sanitary sewers and water lines.
2. This program also provided for the following:
 - a. The milling and resurfacing of Embassy Parkway East and Rosemont Boulevard.
 - b. The construction of a new roadway on the City's (17) seventeen acres off of Ridgewood Road for access to the soccer fields.

B. Soccer Fields

Two soccer fields were constructed on the City's (17) seventeen acres off of Ridgewood Road.

C. Miscellaneous Spot Repairs

Blocks of concrete needed replaced due to the repair of broken water lines. These areas were marked by the Service Department and the replacement was performed by Fabrizi. The majority of this cost was paid by the City of Akron.

D. Ridgewood-Jacoby Roundabout

The City received a grant from the Ohio Public Works Commission in the amount of \$242,261.00 to aid in the construction of a roundabout at the Ridgewood-Jacoby intersection. The application requesting the grant of State Issue 1 Funds was a joint application between the City of Fairlawn, Copley Township and the Summit County Engineers office with the City of Fairlawn being the lead agency.
